

PSM & ESG GO HAND IN HAND

PROCESS SAFETY MANAGEMENT (PSM) IS RELEVANT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL AND GOVERNANCE (ESG) PROGRAMS

ACCORDING TO THE RESULTS OF SPHERA'S SEVENTH ANNUAL SAFETY SURVEY:

Only **13%** of respondents think that process safety management (PSM) does NOT fit into their companies' ESG program. Of the **87%** who DO see a fit between PSM and ESG:



believe that PSM fits within the **governance component** of their companies' ESG program.



say that PSM fits within the **environmental component** of their companies' ESG program.



believe that PSM fits within the **social component** of their companies' ESG program.



of respondents say **environmental impact scenarios** are among the **most concerning** of all impact scenarios.



identify scenarios that **impact human habitation** as among the **most concerning**.



say scenarios that **have legal ramifications** are among the **most concerning**.

Respondents say that **ESG, and the environment in particular**, are relevant to process safety management.

However, respondents say that only **some consideration** is given to **environmental impact** during process safety and risk management evaluations.
